Alberta Learning's new publication *The Journey* is described as “a handbook for parents of children who are gifted and talented.” One parent says she wished it had been available years ago. *The Journey* offers information and strategies that parents of children who are gifted and talented can use to support their children’s learning and emotional well-being at home, in school, and in the community. Parents are the most important people in their children’s life and they play a key role in supporting and nurturing their child’s giftedness.

Parents are invited to share highlights of the handbook with others and discuss how they can use it to advocate for their children. The handbook was a collaboration of the Alberta Associations for Bright Children (AABC) and Alberta Learning. EABC executive member Debra Arnison Sutton was a member of the AABC Steering Committee. She will share AABC’s role in the development of the resource; what their vision was for it; which gifted/talented issues they considered; and go over the structure of the book.
